
SAVE the DATE for CSNA's Summer Conference June 16-18, 2020

It was a sunny day at the end of August 2018. I flew in to Denver International Airport (with some solid turbulence), picked up my rental car, and drove to my potential new job in Aurora Public Schools. As I was driving, I thought to myself, "this is the place I've always wanted to live. Lush streams, massive peaks, and more food and outdoor activities than I can possibly think of!" Then I also thought as I was driving to Aurora, "where are all the mountains"? Colorado is the state where the Great Plains meet the Rockies. It is full of great food and adventure. I have lived here for a little over a year now. I will take you through some of my favorite places, both restaurants and outdoor activities that are a must do and see being new to Colorado.

To become a true Coloradan you must indulge in delicious craft beer and spicy green chilies so one of my favorite places to indulge in a "one stop shop Colorado" is **Bull and Bush Brewery** (they even have Colorado Bison). If it's a nice carb load meal you are looking for after hiking one of Colorado's many 14ers, a stop at **Beau Jo's Pizza** is the place to go. When I went I thought it was extremely strange dipping my crust into honey but turned out to be a delicious treat after a hearty meal. There are great neighborhoods around the Denver area to explore that have really delicious restaurants. Some of my favorites are in the RINO arts district, LoHi, and Wash Park. A greats outside the Denver area is **Slow Groovin BBQ** in Marble, Colorado where they make some of the best Colorado Barbeque in the state. Marble is amazing little town in Gunnison County and is a must see to truly enjoy the beauty and adventure of the state.

When most people outside of Colorado think about the state, they think of endless hiking and recreation. One of my favorite places so far is the Great Sand Dunes National Park. It is an amazing sight from afar and as you drive closer, the dunes are incredible. I went during the early part of spring and was able to see the spring runoff that creates Medano Creek. Before I entered the park I stopped at gift shop and rented a sand board. The hike up the dunes is long and somewhat challenging but worth the ride back down. Also approximately 6 miles from the dunes is another short worthwhile hike to Zapata Falls. Rocky Mountain National Park also a must see. I absolutely loved the scenery and Bear Lake/Fern trail. That trail has amazing views and is highlighted with a cool waterfall. Additionally, taking a trip down Trail Ridge Road was also a great sight. Another favorite hike of mine most recently was near Marble, Colorado called Crystal Mill Trail. The trail is a multi-use trail for both hiking and ATV. Even though it's extremely rocky and dusty at times, it has incredible sights. The trail runs along the Crystal River. While you walk along the trail there are many waterfalls in the distance flowing from the many peaks we encountered. At the end of the trail you come to an old decommissioned mill known as Crystal Mill. It sits right alongside a 20 foot waterfall. The pool at the bottom is full of fish and great for fly fishing. Lastly, a must visit is Gunnison, Colorado. I personally loved it because it is the home of the biggest reservoir in the state, Blue Mesa Reservoir, and also has some incredible fly fishing spots. So yes, if you want to do as Coloradans do, fly fishing is a must. And don't worry, there is a wonderful trail that runs the length of the Gunnison River which takes you in to Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park.

There are so many incredible places in Colorado. I definitely consider myself lucky to have seen a lot of the state. I hope whoever reads this visits some of the places I have mentioned and enjoys them as much as I have. Next things to conquer... white water rafting trip, snowboarding, and possibly a mountain train ride.

## CACFP UPDATE

#### 2019 Annual Reports:

For the past 18 months, the Nutrition Services Branch (NSB) has worked on establishing a performance management system for the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) and Women, Infants and Children Program (WIC).

Development of the system includes identifying overarching goals for the programs, selecting meaningful metrics and data sources and creating visual scoreboards to monitor progress. The performance management system allows NSB to see if programmatic strategies are providing expected results, helps us learn about our work and guide decisions to change course for better outcomes. The system has allowed us to identify gaps and where the programs could use help from partners.

You can find a summary of the goals and results in the 2019 Annual Reports, <u>WIC</u> and <u>CACFP</u>. These reports will help communicate our priorities, progress and focus partnership efforts. They draw from our work through the past year to define and monitor our goals and highlight our larger WIC and CACFP goals that we've been monitoring. For future years, we will draw on the new data and evaluation infrastructure to highlight our progress to our goals on a yearly basis.




