Pass H.R. 5504 Now!

Congress is debating legislation to reauthorize the Child Nutrition Act, but Congressional leaders are struggling to identify the necessary funding to support this legislation. Without a funding "offset," we run the risk of Congress passing another extension of the current law.

In light of this challenge and the rapidly dwindling days left in this congressional session, school nutrition professionals need to call on Congress to immediately identify funding and quickly pass Child Nutrition Reauthorization legislation.
