


# SNS Exam Virtual Study Sessions

Believe it or not, a team full of managers with a ton of experience and knowledge might not be the most productive group.



The Colorado Local Food Program Guidebook, provided by Nourish Colorado, is an online resource for school meal operators, agricultural producers, and school and community members. The Guidebook provides insights and tools for launching, implementing, and sustaining farm to school programs. It is full of custom-designed resources based off of a decade plus of working side-by-side with School Meal Operators, listening to their needs, leading trainings to support their efforts, and now, turning that training content into tangible and digestible resources. We also spent years working closely with Agricultural Producers around the State to better understand their needs when it comes to accessing School Market Channels. Everything in this website is a direct representation of these deep relationships and the best part is we have the ability to keep adding content and links to other resources! Currently - we are adding Spanish versions of every resource in!
